➤ **Headline:** Are mobiles harmful to children?

➤ **By-line:** A new study into whether mobile phones are harmful to children starts at Imperial College London.

➤ **Body:**

A large study into whether mobile phones are harmful to children's health is starting in September. (**WHAT AND WHEN**).

It's being funded by the government and mobile phone companies and it will involve 2,500 children aged between eleven and twelve. (**WHO**).

Scientists from Imperial College London (**WHERE**) will look at their thinking skills, memory and attention - and will then repeat the same tests in 2017. (**HOW**)

Researchers say very little is known about the effects these technologies have on children's brains and it's important we find out. (**WHY**)
